*Transformer from US border to foundation*



This 172,100 lbs transformer crossed the border from Mexico to the United States at HLL's Laredo, TX transload facility. From there HLL railed it to a rail siding close to its future home in Decatur, AL. The rigging crew met the unit at the rail siding with an all terrain crane and loaded it to a transport trailer.



Once it had been transloaded, the transformer traveled a short distance over roads to the substation it had been manufactured to join. At the final site, the crew used the same all terrain crane to lift the unit off the transport trailer and set it safely on the customer's pad. With the delivery completed, the transformer awaited final assembly.
