*TAD Rolls, Yankee Dryer and Hoods/Toes.*



This complex project involved four different commodities coming together for a new paper plant, in Macon, Georgia. HLI coordinated the planning, ocean freight, unloading and transportation of a Yankee Dryer with Hoods/Toes from Karlstad, Sweden, with a separate commodity of TAD Rolls coming from their manufacture in Portland Maine, in two phases.

Phase 1: The TAD rolls were collected and delivered to the Port of Maine, and barged to the Port of Savannah, where the Yankee Dryer and Hoods also arrived. Upon arrival of the barge from Manie, the Hood/Toes were unloaded to awaiting trucks.



The Yankee and TAD Rolls were loaded to the barge, to be barged to the Port of Brunswick, GA. Concurrently, HLI supervised the unloading at site of the Hoods.

Phase 2: HLI's crew met the barge at the Port of Brunswick, GA, with a floating crane ready to unload the TADS/Yankee Dryer to trailers. The delivery of the Yankee Dryer and TAD rolls took place over a period of weeks due to Georgia DOT requirements. At the final delivery site, HLI's crew supervised the unloading by crane and necessary rigging gear.
