PROJECT B-12400 Transformer from port of entry to foundation











The transformer entered the United States on a railcar in Eagle Pass, TX. HLI then coordinated the delivery to a rail siding in Anaheim, CA, where it was then transferred to a transport trailer, for the final portion of the delivery to the substation. Once arrived at the rail siding, HLI's crew set to work, unleashing the transformer from the railcar, and preparing for the rigging crew to lift and transload it to the transport trailer.

With the transformer loaded and secured on the transport trailer, HLI's crew began the over-road haul to the final site in Anaheim, CA. Once at its destination within the substation, the transformer was offloaded from its trailer using another crane and placed at a temporary site waiting for its permanent pad to be finished. Careful planning and execution facilitated a safe and efficient drive allowing the unit to arrive at the substation incident free.
