PROJECT B-14299 Yankee Dryer Transportation





HLI transported a Yankee Dryer – a pressure vessel used in the production of tissue paper – 135 miles from the Port of San Diego, CA to Mexicali, MX. Dimensions of the unit were 19'07"L x 16' 09"W x 17'H, weighing 187,329Lbs. HLI chose a 19 axle trailer for the move. Once HLI's team had mobilized to the port, offloading of the Dryer commenced. The Dryer was transloaded from the ship to a specialized transporter.





Once safely secured, police arrived to inspect the trailer. The trailer and cargo were cleared to move, but was delayed by one day due to weather. Much planning was involved, due to the cross-border delivery of the cargo to the customers site in Mexico. Road signs and overhead obstructions needed to be removed and reset after the cargo passed, in both the US and Mexico. Overhead power lines had to be lifted to facilitate the safe passage of the Yankee Dryer on its trailer. HLI also coordinated with Mexican customs to acquire clearance to cross the border.
