HLI coordinated, the collection and delivery of a TAD roll, which is a Through Air Dryer, Hoods and accessories for delivery to the Port of Portland, Maine (ME), for their onward journey to Tokyo. On the date determined by the customer, HLI's team arrived at the customers plant in Biddeford, ME. TAD Roll was lowered onto a 3 Bed Goldhofer transport trailer received the TAD roll. It was lowered onto the Goldhofer trailer by utilizing the customers on site overhead indoor crane.

Once secured, it began its slow and meticulous journey to the port, followed by an additional two trailers carrying the hoods and accessories. A 50' Bridge Jumper was also employed to safely pass over two bridges along the route. Upon arrival at the port, the trailers were parked as the shipping vessel had yet to arrive. Two weeks later HLI's crew remobilized to the port and moved ship side. Crew then assembled the rigging to commence the lifting of the TAD roll into the cargo hold of the ship, followed by the hoods and accessories. The job was completed without any incidents, on time, and within budget.
